## **WORSHIP**

Kids groups participate in worship throughout the school year. Directors provide worship schedules to members of the groups. Our kids groups present two musicals each year: one on Christmas Eve and one at the end of April.

Our kids music leaders guide children in their musical learning, social interaction, and spiritual growth. They have completed training in our child protection program.

Youth in GRADES 7-12 can participate in choral, handbell, instrumental, and praise band groups throughout the year. These groups are open to all students who want to develop and serve musically even if they aren't regularly part of our congregation.
